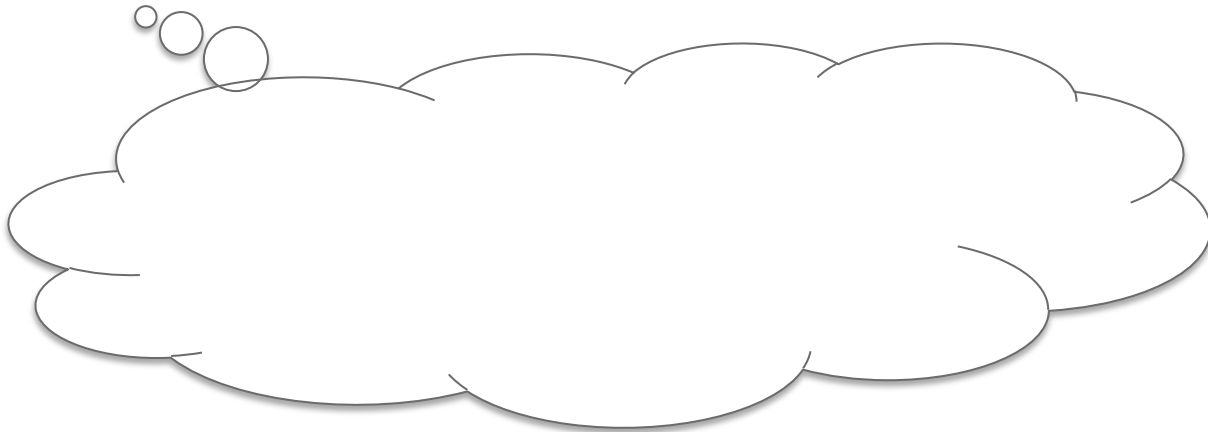
But what happens to the hearts of the people?

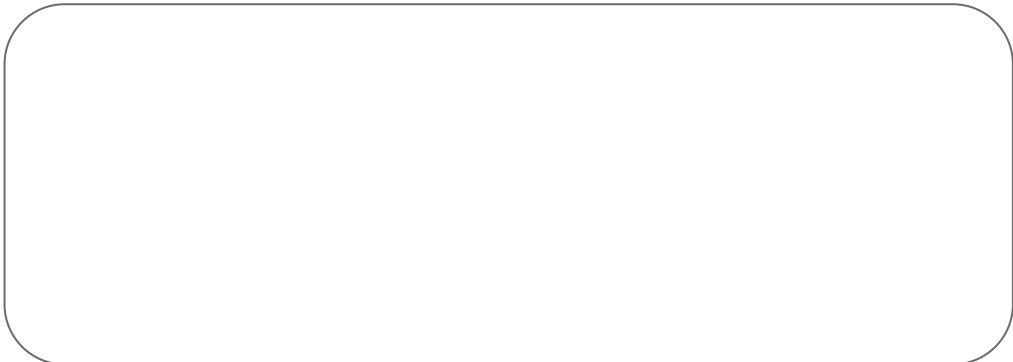

Are they obeying or disobeying as they go up to fight the Amorites? Draw what happens next.

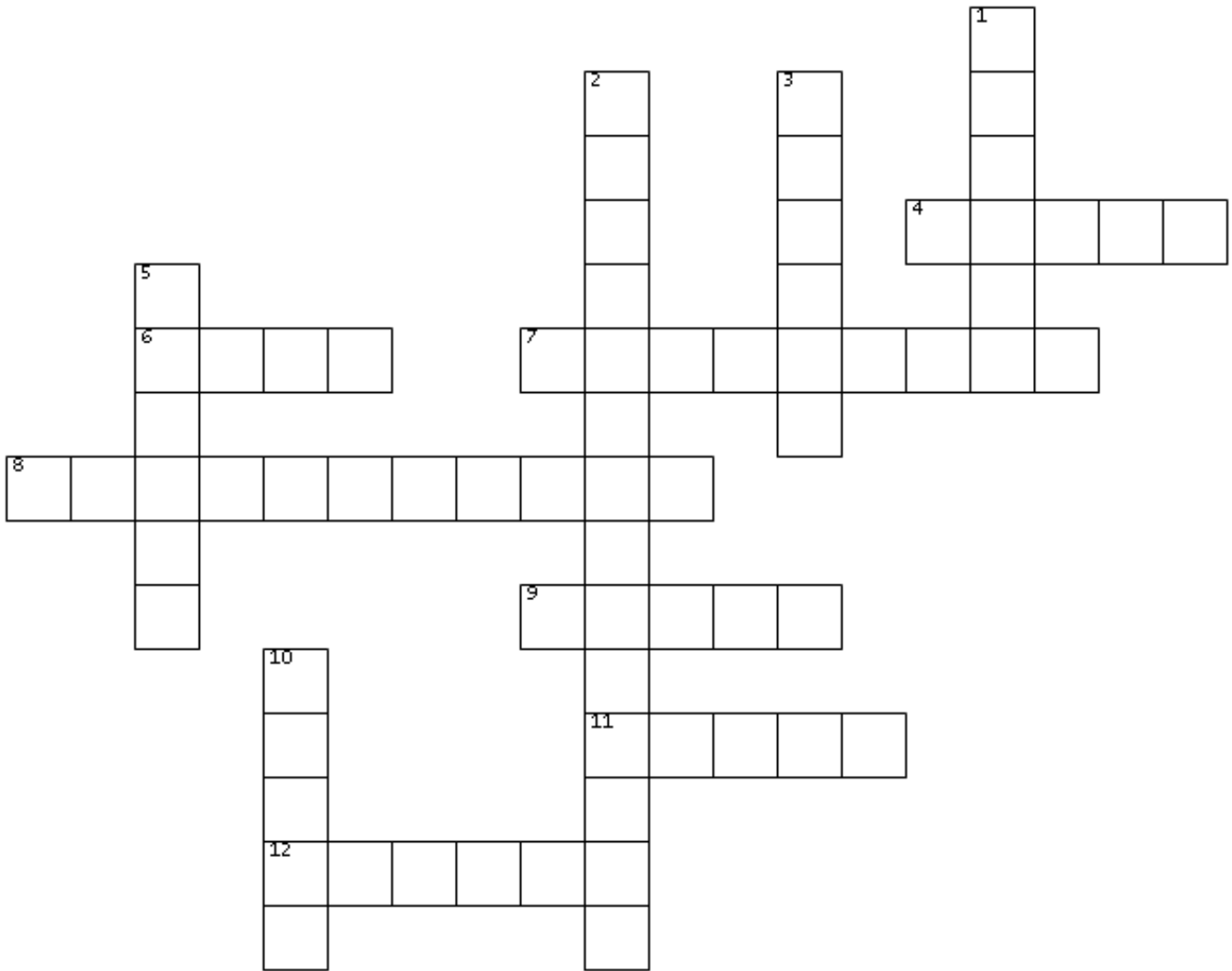
